

LICENSE PLATE ACTIVITY

Read carefully and complete the template on the next page by following instructions to create your own license plate as we get ready to "travel" all around the United States of America! **Be sure to use a COMPOSITION book (preferably 100 sheets and wide ruled), NOT a spiral.**

Do NOT be late as this will incur late points for your first grade in Social Studies!

1. In the upper left hand corner, write the month and day that you were born.
2. In the upper right hand corner, write your first and last name.
3. In the upper middle space, write the name of the state or country of your birth. (My dad was in the Navy ☺.)
4. In the center space, use exactly 6 numbers and/or letters to say something about YOU.
5. Use the bottom of the page to draw 3 things that you like, collect, or do.
6. Completely color your license plate to look nice. Use a LIGHT background (colored pencils or crayons) so that your work can be seen.
7. Cut out and glue your completed License Plate to the front cover of your Composition book.
8. Using packaging tape, secure it to the front cover so that no paper is left exposed.
